

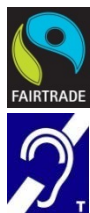

Esta Vida!

On Wednesday 4th November at 7:30pm, investigative journalist Matt Roper visits St. Mary's Parish Centre as his film 'Esta Vida' - 'This Life' will be shown.

Matt was shocked to observe the sexual exploitation of young girls in Brazil, in particular that it was often their mothers and grandmothers who forced them into it, and that the local and regional government pretended it didn't happen so that they didn't have to do anything about it.

Matt decided to do something, and set up Meninadanca, to use dance as a way of helping these girls realise they have value and that their lives could be different.
